

ISO 9001:2008 Quality management system

Name «ISO» is used all around the world to name «International Organization for Standardization», it was founded in year 1947 and is non-governmental organization, and has consultative status in the UNO. The main aim of ISO is development of standardization and related activities in whole world. The first version of system of standards ISO 9000 was worked out in year 1987 on basis of standards of British standardization organization and American quality standards for finished goods MIL-Q-9A58, accepted from USA Department of Defense in year 1959. In essence these standards contained requirements on system availability for quality ensuring to contractors of Pentagon.

ISO (ISO 9000, 9001 and others) – it is a group of standards, oriented mostly on management. On so-called Quality Management System. In contrast to from past known states standards (ГОСТ), this system standardizes not products and those quality, but management processes. And if these processes correspond to standards, than their maintenance brings to specified product quality, high service level, satisfaction of costumers and other wanted results of activities. Standards ISO are applied in any conditions to any company, because they are corresponding to management processes.
